The office will be closed **Monday, December 24** in observance of Christmas Eve and remain closed Tuesday, December 25, <u>Christmas Day</u>.


The office will be open, 9AM-12PM on Wednesday, December 26 and Thursday, December 27.

Our Fall 2018 generosity campaign was a success, thanks to your response.

As of publication, we have received 66 Estimates of Giving to God through Mary Esther UMC for 2019 from individuals and families for a total of \$347,134. This is an average of more than \$5,260 per giving unit! WOW! More than 50% of the estimates received indicate an increase in giving over 2018 with 11 families stepping up TOWARD tithing, 7 families stepping up TO tithing, and a whopping 22 families stepping up BEYOND the tithe! What an incredible faithful response to the God who is always faithful to us!

Now the Committee on Finance is busily working to project a 2019 budget which will put your commitment to work in ministry for Jesus Christ.

REAL Presence: A Worship Series for Advent-Christmas-Epiphany



The culture we live in is full of fake, right now -- the artificial, inauthentic, and bogus. So much of the news? FAKE. How about our so-called "friends" on social media? They "like" you one minute, and in the next they are burning up your feed because you dared to be REAL!

For many of us, even the decoration of our homes and public spaces are artificial copies of pine, cedar, and mistletoe. There is nothing wrong with it, however it begs the question: As we approach this holy-day, what is really REAL?

The Incarnation of Jesus is all about REAL things - flesh and blood, childbirth, true joy, genuine community - things which God brings to us that we can taste, touch, smell, hear and see. God empowers us to become Christ's REAL body and blood in our schools, our neighborhoods, our families, our workplaces, EVERYWHERE.

As a reminder of the reality of God's presence with us, we will enjoy Holy Communion each Sunday during the Advent Season.


