



Florida's Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) is a FREE program to prepare 4-year-olds for success in Kindergarten and beyond. To qualify, parents/guardians must be Florida residents and children must be 4 years old on or before 09/01/2024.
The child's date of birth must fall between 09/02/19 and 09/01/20. Additionally, a child who resides in Florida and turns 4 between February 2 and September 1 may attend VPK either that program year or the subsequent program year.

Parents/guardians <u>MUST</u> provide <u>ONE</u> document from <u>EACH</u> of the two categories below to be issued a certificate for their child:
